Dear Roosevelt Community,

I wanted to update you on a few important initiatives to support our students and families.

New Meal Distribution Schedule

To date, our district has provided more than 100,000 meals to students in our community. To allow families more flexibility, while maintaining social distancing between students, families and staff during meal distribution times, we are consolidating our meal distribution schedule beginning next week.

Starting on Monday, April 20, we will be serving meals to students twice a week on **Mondays and Thursdays only**.

As we consider the needs of our students and families during this unprecedented time, we are excited to now provide an extra meal for Saturday to support our students over the weekend. Families with children 18 years of age and younger will be able to pick up three breakfast and lunch meals on Monday and pick up three breakfast and lunch meals on Thursday for the rest of the week, including Saturday.

Children do not need to be present at meal pick-up. However, if children are NOT present at pick-up, parents/guardians will need one of the following:

1. A student ID card, report card, or other school issued documentation with child's name.
2. Show a video call home to show their children at home.
3. For children not enrolled in school: documentation with a child's name and date of birth.
4. If unable to provide any of the above is able to be provided, staff will ask for the parent/guardian's name, child's name and school (or date of birth if not enrolled in school) which will be written down by staff.

(Note: These forms of proof just need to be shown and will not be collected or touched.)

The existing Mobile meal program will also continue at bus stop locations and will include some school sites on the bus routes.

Beginning April 20, 2020 the following schools will transition to become designated bus route locations.

Please note: existing bus route stops and meal delivery times will not change except for one (Bus Route #5) that will be delivering a half hour earlier starting at 10:30 a.m. to 11:35 a.m. at Arbor Village, Lazy D Mobile Home Park and Monte Vista Apartments.

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Remote Learning Experiences – Apple iPad Distribution and Learning Packet Distribution

To keep our students engaged in learning our administrators distributed more than 6,500 Apple iPads to students last week. Also, we are working with families to secure WiFi access.

Learning tasks in the packets will be used in conjunction with online lessons that students are completing on their iPads.
